YFD Established in 2013 with the authorization of the Ministry of Social Affairs and Labor NO. (123)

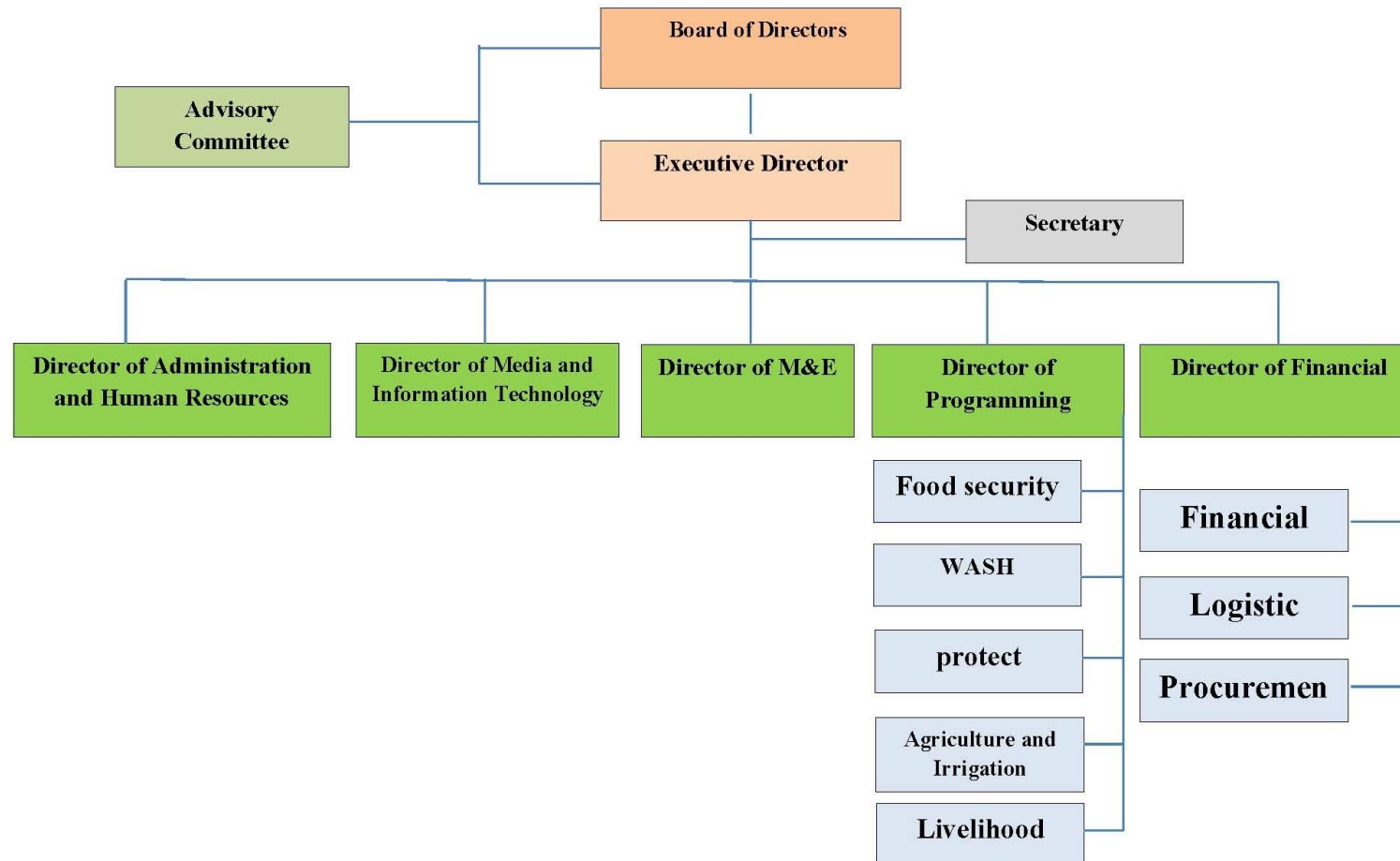
YFD had Registration with SCHAMCHA No. (434)
